- ii. After omitting the topic chain surveying, the first unit may start with compass surveying. Total station and GPS can be highlighted.
- iii. Recent edition of publication has to be included in all subjects as reference books.
- iv. In Computer Aided Civil Engineering Drawing, softwares like Archicad and SketchUp can be introduced.
- v. Electrical layout of a residential building and demo can be included in the unit 3 of Computer Aided Civil Engineering Drawing followed by field applications in the unit 5.
